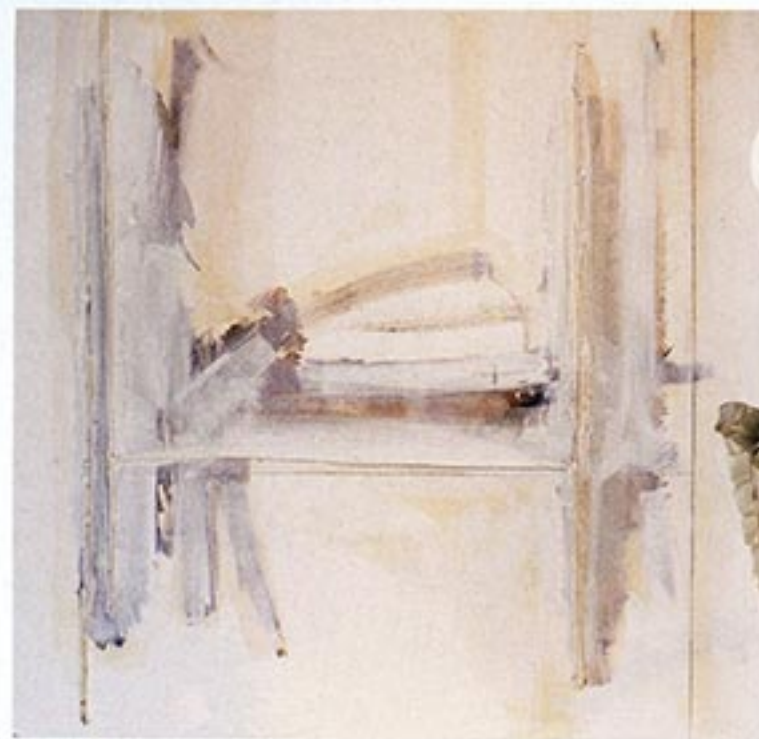
My Favorite Things

A mix of global influence and personal significance distinguishes interior designer Kira Krümm's style. By Jennifer Freihofer

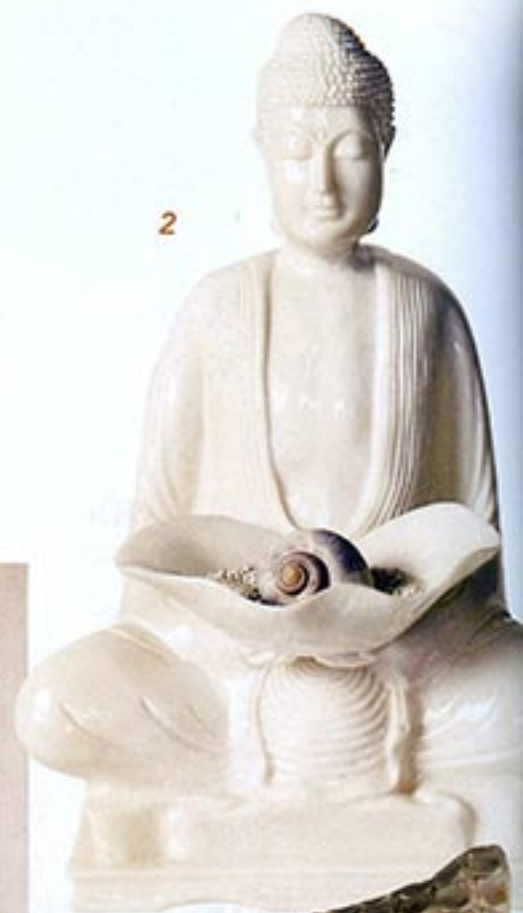
