ECO-FRIENDLY DESIGN

MORE AND MORE, THE ECO-CONSCIOUS are incorporating green design into all aspects of their homes.

In creating a nursery for her son, Marco, interior designer Kira Krümm focused on a space that would be tranquil, pure and simple, ultimately good for her baby and good for the environment, as well.

The crib, she says, was the first and most important selection. She chose a contemporary-style crib made of New Zealand pine wood from sustainable forests that is lead- and phthalate-free and can later convert into a toddler bed. Even

the carpet—which is made of corn—is environmentally safe.

Keeping with her signature coastal aesthetic, Krümm gravitated toward light neutrals with touches of dark wood. Done in shades of cream, khaki and soft green, the crib set by Nature's Purest Collection is 100 percent premium organically grown cotton with no pesticides, chemicals or dyes.
