Growing overseas interest in American fine art and interior design has prompted local designer Kira Krümm to pursue a wide international market.

Her Kira Krümm Interior Design firm will do business abroad under the name Kira Krümm International Design, according to publicist Elizabeth Hendrix.

Hendrix said the move comes as a result of partnerships with "key industry leaders and cultural collaborations throughout Asia, Europe and the Americas."

Krümm's inspiration comes from her natural surroundings. With color schemes, she suggest beginning with light neutral backgrounds, then introducing contrast and accents in art, accessories, and wood finishes, in keeping with the existing architecture and natural environment.

"I get to know my client's tastes and overall lifestyle as well as determine their design priorities in the home and if there are any pre-existing elements they wish to incorporate," said Krümm.
"Although, as a designer, I contribute vision, guide the aesthetic decisions and 'make it happen,' my clients drive the design direction. My objective is to create an environment that our clients will identify with and enjoy."
